Tara (name changed for confidentiality) recently came to us for pregnancy testing She did not want to be pregnant and was anxious about the possibility. Tara's worst fear was realized when her test result showed positive. She had always believed that she would never have an abortion but now she was not so sure. Her relationships were complicated and beside that, she didn't see how she could have a baby with everything else that was going on in her life. She didn't know much at all about abortion and therefore wanted our staff to discuss with her, her pregnancy options and in particular, what was involved in having an abortion. Tara was emotional during her visit, shedding many tears throughout. She left that day still undecided about what she would do. Our prayer partners continued praying for her and a few days later she called to share that she planned to continue her pregnancy. In a subsequent visit, Tara appeared much more relaxed and at peace with her pregnancy. We

praise God for her decision and for steering her heart away from the pain and hurt that abortion would have brought to it. The Earn While You Learn program was explained to Tara during her initial visit and she expressed interest in enrolling in it. We look forward to walking alongside Tara during her pregnancy and beyond, offering her emotional, spiritual and material support.

FINANCIAL UPDATE THROUGH OCTOBER 2019

We feel so incredibly blessed by the Lord this year. Three years ago our cash flow was so low that we didn't know how we were going to pay our bills. A change began to occur last year and especially this year - the number of monthly donors increased and this year's Walk for Life and Baby Bottle Blessings both broke giving records, coming in over \$30,000!!

God knew we would need these extra funds to transition a new person into the Executive Director position and to spend more dollars on marketing to at -risk clients. In addition, the board of directors will be considering expanding the center's reach into other areas in southern West Virginia and southwest Virginia. We are excited to see what new things God is getting ready to do!!
